

**Town of Stockton Board Meeting Minutes

**11. Town Board response to Railroad Commissioner decision on Old Hwy 18 crossing**

The Town Board agreed with the Hearing Examiners recommendations to the Railroad Commissioner as follows.

1. Wisconsin Central Ltd. shall perform minor repairs to the Old Hwy 18 crossing rails prior to Oct. 1, 2009.
2. Town of Stockton shall reconstruct crossing at grade road as planned using the DOT Highway Safety Improvement Program prior to Oct. 1, 2011.
3. Railroad shall install and maintain flashing lights with gates prior to Oct. 1, 2011.
4. Wisconsin Central shall submit to the Railroad Commission cost estimate of installation of the gates and lights to the Railroad Commissioner and the DOT.
5. Signal installation shall not begin until federal funds are available.
6. Railroad shall notify the Railroad Commissioner office when signals are installed.
7. Town of Stockton shall install and maintain an advance warning signs prior to Oct. 1, 2009.
8. Town of Stockton shall install and maintain parallel tracks advance warning signs for Old Hwy 18 west bound traffic prior to Oct. 1, 2009.
9. Wisconsin Central and Town of Stockton shall each bear 50% of the local match required by project participation in the Highway Safety Improvement Program.
10. Wisconsin Central and Town of Stockton shall bear no cost of the crossing signal materials and installation except for the cost assessed to the railroad ss. 195.60.
