

Town of Stockton Board Informational Meeting Minutes
Monday, June 7, 2004 6:00PM
At the Stockton Municipal Building

1. **Call to Order:** Chairman Borski called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.
 - In Attendance: Supervisors Pehoski and Cychosz, Sandra Van Asten, Greg Tamason. Representing the DOT, Dave Barth and Earth Tech were Randall Fuch and Jeff Knudson
 - Others in Attendance: see the attached sheet
2. Discussion about the three options presented concerning the Hwy 10 Bypass are as follows:

HH-J option

- Hwy 10 & Cty J interchange would become a Collector Distribution System – current Hwy 10 lanes would be used but under the Cty J bridge 8 lanes would be needed.
- At County Concrete would be an interchange with local access
- Upgraded Hwy 10 would remain but would need to be upgrade from a freeway to an expressway, so not all of the upgraded Hwy 10 would be used but added to.
- Custer will have a bridge but no local access.
- County K and Hwy 10 interchange would need to be moved to the north
- Bridges would go over Old Hwy 18, Burbank Rd and the railroad tracks making it a very long bridge and the Historical school would need to be moved.

Option 1

- 4 lane County J interchange would be placed 1000' west or east of Gray Log Lane subdivision.
- Bypass would be 200' north of Gray Log Lane subdivision lot line.

Option 2

- 4 lane County J interchange would be placed 1000' west or east of Gray Log Lane subdivision.
- Cty K and residents to the north would need to use frontage roads to access Hwy 10

DOT will compare all the options and include all the data needed to help make the final decision on which options best serves the Hwy 10 Bypass.

Public hearing on the final option would be held in September or October 2004.

Land selected for the Hwy 10 Bypass will remain to be used as presently used and taxed as used.

Mobile Home Buy Out cost is the same as a home resident buy out because the tenant must be relocated to a comparable residence and must also be moved.
